

ICONS

Icons are used after each recommendation to describe the recommendation's type, degree of importance, and relative cost.

TYPE ICONS

To illustrate the means for implementation, the following icons are used.



Policy. The recommendation is a policy to be implemented by resolution, ordinance, or directive.



Program. The recommendation is a program to be implemented by County staff, community leaders, or local organizations.



Project. The recommendation is a construction or other type of project with a defined start and end date.

PRIORITY ICONS

To illustrate the level of priority, the following icons are used.



High Priority. The recommendation is highest priority. It will have the greatest impact on achieving the Goal.



Medium Priority. The recommendation is moderate priority. It will have a significant impact on achieving the Goal.



Low Priority. The recommendation is low priority. While less important than others, it is still important for achieving the Goal.

COST ICONS

To illustrate the level of resources necessary to implement the recommendation, the following icons are used.



High Cost. The recommendation requires significant resources; for example, a high percentage of staff time and/or funding typically beyond normal budgets.



Moderate Cost. The recommendation requires moderate resources; for example, a moderate amount of staff time and/or a notable amount of funding that may still be accommodated by normal budgets or may require limited additional funding.



Low Cost. The recommendation requires a low level of resources; for example, a minimal amount of staff time and/or a nominal amount of funding.
