CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Argerbright called the regular meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

ROLL CALL

Mr. Argerbright read roll call. All members present and absent are listed above.

BUSCHE PROJECT UPDATE

Mr. Buuck gave an update on the project. He stated that the building materials were to be coming in August and moving along. Discussion was made regarding the sewer extension to the property. Mr. Hill stated that he was still waiting on the engineering plans of the project. Once plans are received, the plan is to move forward quickly with the work. Mr. Argerbright asked for a member volunteer to be on a committee for the sewer extension. Mr. Schrader volunteered to serve on the committee with Mr. Argerbright. Mr. Wagner discussed the possibility of including and connecting Gateway East to the sewer at the same time.

LARWILL SEWER UPDATE

Mr. Wagner provided an update on the Larwill Sewer project. He stated that the two locations had been connected. He discussed issues that had come up at the time of connection and a special tool that was needed to activate the pump. Parts were needed and ordered to repair pump issue and would be taken care of soon. Mr. Wheeler discussed connection to the second site on the parcel that was not connected. Mr. Argerbright stated that he and Mr. Wheeler would be attending the next Larwill Town meeting. He also stated that a meeting would be held soon with BCS to go over the final billing. Mr. Wheeler asked if the tanks were filled in. Mr. Wagner confirmed that they were pumped and filled in.

RAIL CONNECT PROPERTY UPDATE

Mr. Boxberger discussed the property and the purchase agreement. He stated that some wording was changed, and disclaimers added in the purchase agreement regarding soil conditions. Mr. Buuck stated that the second appraisal should be coming to him soon. Mr. Argerbright asked if this needed new approval. Mr. Boxberger confirmed that it did. Mr. Schrader made a motion to approve the purchase

agreement with Ambassador Enterprises, LLC., with the changed that were made. Seconded by Mr. Kessler. Motion passed with a vote of 4-0.

MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS

Mr. Bilger discussed the TIF neutralization and that the reports had been sent into the state.
